Main objectives of POEM SET project

- ✓ To train healthcare educators on how to develop simulation-enhanced training for undergraduate students focusing on non-technical skills through the implementation of a summer camp [WP1]
- ✓ To build universities' digital capacity through the implementation of training and design of a serious game [WP2]
- ✓ To collect hard data on the added value of the serious game prior to on-site simulation (=blended learning) to improve non-technical skills [WP3]
- ✓ To strengthen multiple disciplinary and intercultural training at the undergraduate level through the implementation of a European COIL program and a summer school [WP4]

Identify the positive axes, to be improved and discussed in the progress of the POEM SET Erasmus + project

General mapping

Access to the Université Paris Cité university campus "Saints Pères" and Ilumens simulation Center – University Campus « Saints Pères » 45, rue des Saints Pères, 75006 Paris; 6th floor

1) From **Roissy Charles de Gaulle airport**

- Take REB B at "Roissy Airport" up to "Saint Michel Notre Dame"
- Take metro 4 at "Saint Michel Notre Dame" up to "Saint Germain des Prés" (direction : Bagneux Lucie Aubrac)
- 5 min walk till Saints Pères Building

OR

- Take Roissy Bus at Roissy Airport up to "Opéra"
- Take Metro 7 (direction: Villejuif Louis Aragon or Mairie d'Ivry) up to "Pyramides"
- Take Metro 14 (direction: Olympiades) up to "Châtelet"
- Take Metro 4 at "Châtelet" (direction: Bagneux Lucie Aubrac) up to "Saint Germain des Prés"
- 5 min walk till Saints Pères Building

2) From **Orly Airport**

- Take OrlyVal towards Antony
- Take REB B at "Antony" up to "Saint Michel Notre Dame"
- Take metro 4 at "Saint Michel Notre Dame" up to "Saint Germain des Prés" (direction : Bagneux Lucie Aubrac)
- 5 min walk till Saints Pères Building

OR

- Take Orly Bus at Orly Airport up to "Denfert Rochereau"
- Take Metro 4 (direction: Porte de Clignacourt) up to "Saint Germain des Prés"
- 5 min walk till Saints Pères Building

3) From **Gare du Nord**

- Take Metro 4 (direction: Bagneux Lucie Aubrac) up to "Saint Germain des Prés"
- 5 min walk till Saints Pères Building
